## Rules & Conditions of Entry.

### Categories:

#### **A. Traditional Scarecrow.**

For centuries scarecrows have been build to scare away birds in gardens and on farms. An old favourite, give us your scariest, funniest or just best scarecrow.

#### **B. Contemporary Scarecrow**

Limited only by your imagination. Think outside the box.

### Scarecrow Rules:

1. Your entry must be in "good taste" Coal Creek Community Park & Museum reserves the right to refuse to display any entry if it is considered inappropriate or dangerous.
2. Scarecrows will be on display for a 2 week period. All materials and props must be securely attached and be durable enough to withstand and tolerate outdoor conditions.
3. Scarecrows must be built on a garden stake or equivalent 25mm x 25mm. You MUST leave a minimum clearance of 40mm at the bottom of your stake to allow for it to be secured on site.
4. Coal Creek Community Park & Museum reserves the right to photograph entries for any promotional purpose. Photographs will become the property of Coal Creek Community Park & Museum.
5. Advertising/Promotion of businesses, Groups, Organizations will be allowed on scarecrows.
6. Maximum height 2.5 metres, maximum width 2.0 metres
7. Scarecrows are to be delivered to Coal Creek Community Park & Museum between Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> October during normal operation hours of 10am – 4.00pm. Our Staff/Volunteers will erect the scarecrow prior to Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> October.
8. Scarecrows must be picked up on Sunday 7th November 2010 between 2pm - 4p.m unless prior arrangement has been made. Any scarecrows unclaimed will be disposed of.
9. A panel of judges will decide on winners, their decision is final and no discussion will be entered into.
10. Winners will be announced and prizes awarded at 7pm at the Halloween at Coal Creek Event on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> October.
